Age Range: School students 5-7 years

Class Structure: Three units, 30 weeks per unit

This program offers:

- Structured Mandarin lessons for age appropriate classes for school students. Objective is to develop basic mandarin language skills, mastering 150+ vocabularies and 20 sentence patterns. ***Emphasis on listening and speaking with character recognition and basic writing skill.**
- Students-centred class designed. Small sized group of children (maximum 10 children). Each child will be engaged to express themselves and receive fair chance to speak out.
- Learn through fun activities such as, games involving speaking of Mandarin, listening to Chinese songs and singing along; role play, craft and art and story telling.
- Learning not only the language but the Chinese culture and Chinese festivals with children books and cartoons.
- Students will receive a multi-media teaching environment. Every individual will be interacting with computer learning along with the Best CSL (Chinese as Second Language) curriculum books.
- Immersion learning environment. Teachers are required to mainly speak Mandarin in class using images and gestures to assist. Students' listening and speaking skills will be greatly developed.
